# **Reporting to Premises Manager**

#### **Duties**

- Moving and lifting of chairs on and off tables to aid cleaning
- Emptying waste bins or similar receptacles, transporting waste material to designated collection points
- Sweeping hard floors with brushes or dust control mops
- Mopping floors with wet or damp mops
- Vacuum cleaning carpeted areas and 'spot' cleaning carpets
- To dust, damp wipe, wash or polish furniture, ledges, windowsills, external surfaces of cupboards, radiators, shelves and fitments
- To clean/sterilise desktops daily
- To clean toilets, urinals, hand basins and sinks
- To use such chemical agents as directed by the supervising officer (after receiving proper instruction and training)
- To undertake wall washing or inside window pane cleaning to a height no greater than body height plus an arm's extension from the floor level, during periodic cleaning and maintenance programmes
- On occasion, to be available for deep clean programmes during school holidays, for which prior notice will be given. To carry out any other reasonable duties within the overall function of the job.
